# *Looking for the Goshawk* *– The Lost Raptor*

Conor talks about his journey in writing the book *Looking for the Goshawk*. It's a personal, narrative account of the natural history of this mystery-shrouded bird of prey: how it lives, where it lives, across the northern hemisphere, and why it might be missing from most of the UK. Conor's search takes him to some unexpected places, including Eastern Europe and upstate New York. The talk focuses on how this adventure turned into the essay which won BBC Wildlife Nature Writer of the Year, and then the book, which received support from the Society of Authors and the Royal Literary Fund.
